BEFORE YOU BEGIN

Read these instructions completely and carefully.

Prepare Electrical Wiring

- Acceptable for use in dry, damp and wet locations
- Follow all National Electric Codes (NEC) and local codes.
- This product is intended to be installed and serviced by a qualified, licensed electrician.
- Ensure applicable wire is installed between driver, fixture, and any controls in between.
- When choosing wire, factor in voltage drop, amperage rating, and type (in-wall rated, wet location rated, etc.). *Inadequate wire installation* could overheat wires, and cause a fire.
- Do not install if product has any visible damage.
- Do not modify or disassemble this product beyond instructions or the warranty will be void.



WARNING

RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK

- Turn power off before inspection, installation or removal.
- Properly ground power supply.

RISK OF FIRE

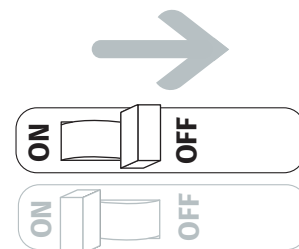
- Use only UL approved wire for input/output connections
- Minimum wire size 18 AWG
- Follow all NEC and local codes.



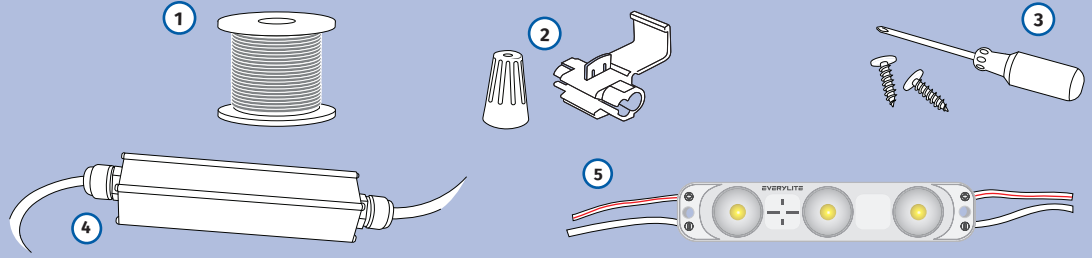

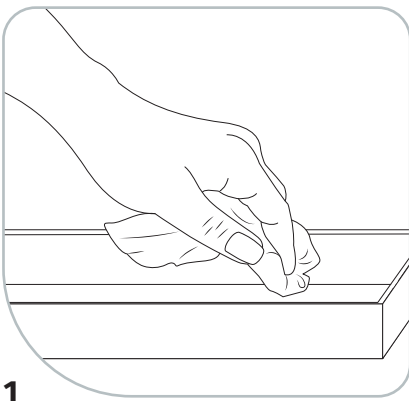

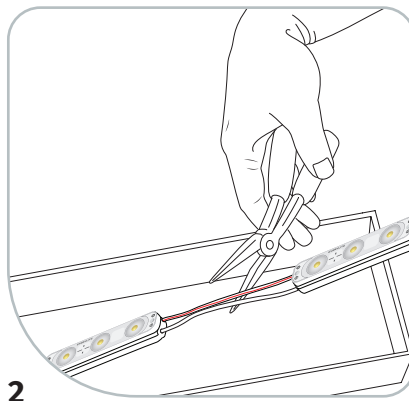
- 1 - UL approved supply wire
- 2 - UL approved twist-on wire connectors or In-line/IDC connectors
- 3 - Screws, rivets, electronic grade silicone or equivalent
- 4 - 12 Volt Power Supply
- 5 - LED Modules



Layout Modules

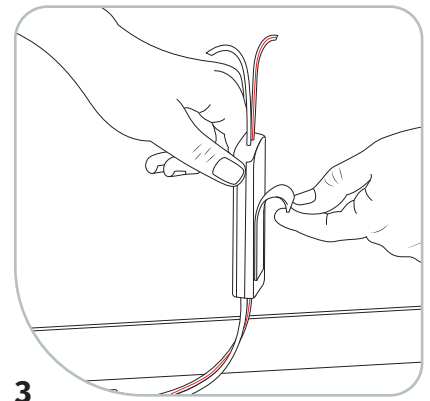

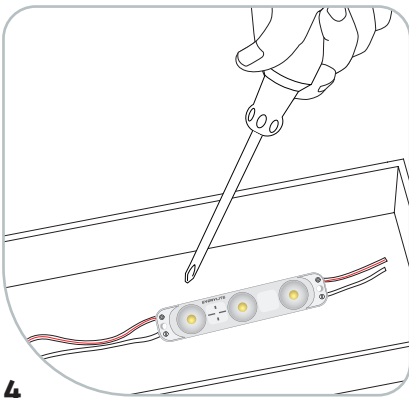

Measure and cut LED modules to the appropriate length for each letter. Cuts can be made between any of the modules.



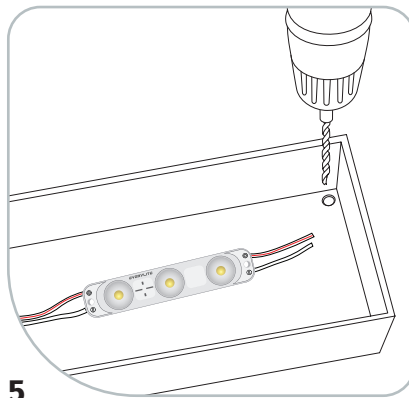

Remove tape backing and stick LED modules into place. Continue until you have reached the end of the run.



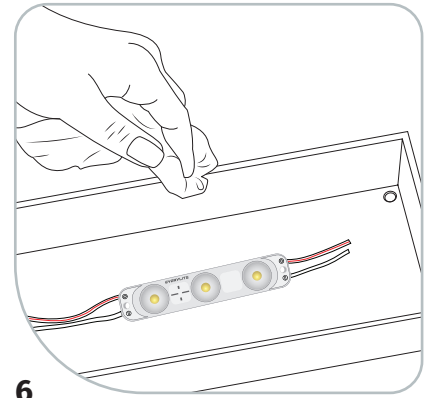

Use rivets, screws, or silicone to secure at least every fifth LED module within the channel letter.

Drill a 1/4" hole near the LED strip and grommet the hole for supply wire access.



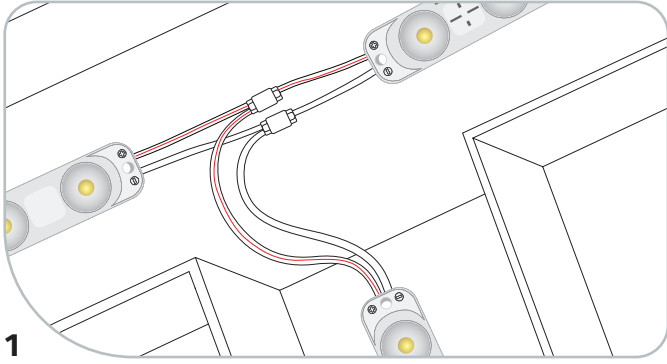

Clean and remove all debris from the inside of the channel letter. Replace sign face.

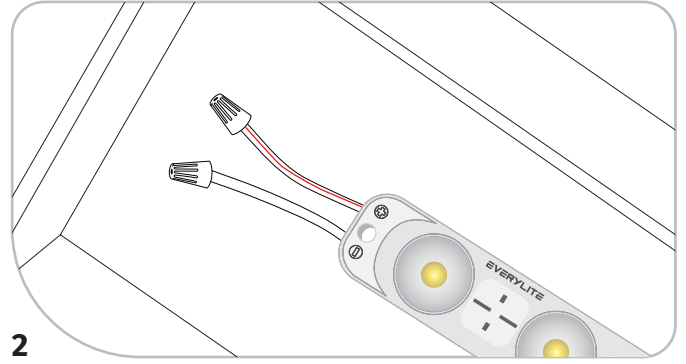


NOTE: For halo-lit applications LED modules should be mounted on UL-recognized clear acrylic or polycarbonate. The light output from the LED system should be directed back into the sign enclosure. This will allow for uniform backlighting of the sign and will provide simple mounting.

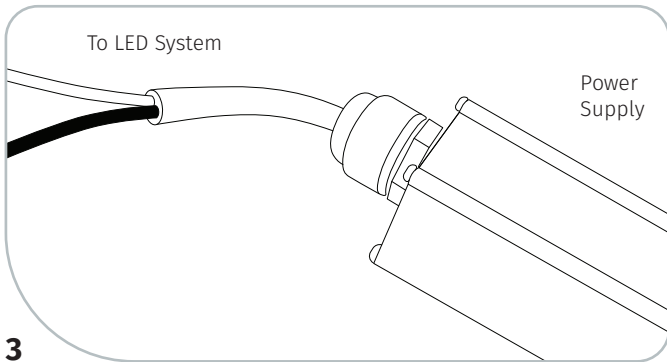




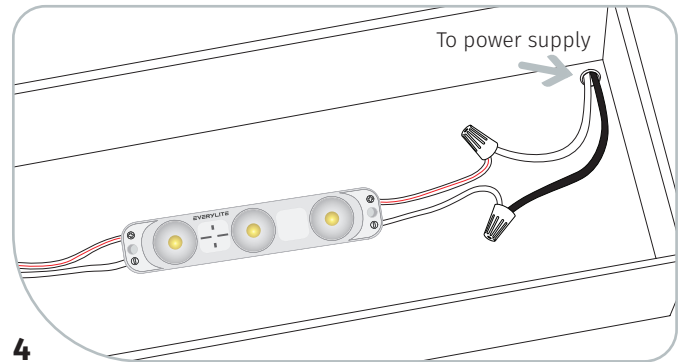
1 Connect LED strips using in-line (IDC) connectors or twist-on wire connectors.



2 Must cap all exposed wires with appropriate wire connectors.



3 Run a wire from the power supply to each channel letter and connect to the first LED module on the strip.

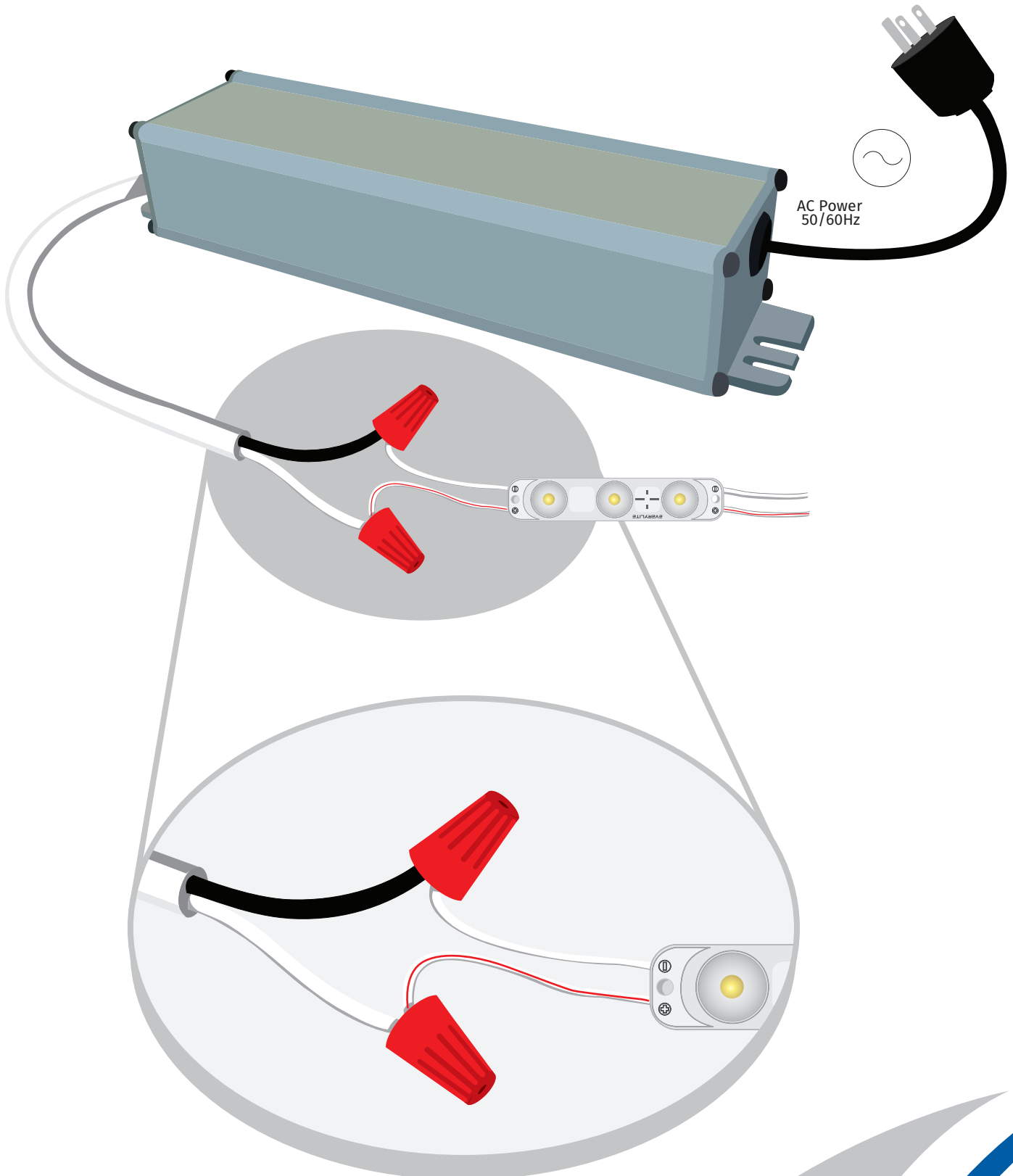


4 Connect the red striped wire (+) of the LED strip to the red wire (+) of the power supply. Connect the white wire (-) of the LED strip to the black or blue wire (-) of the power supply.



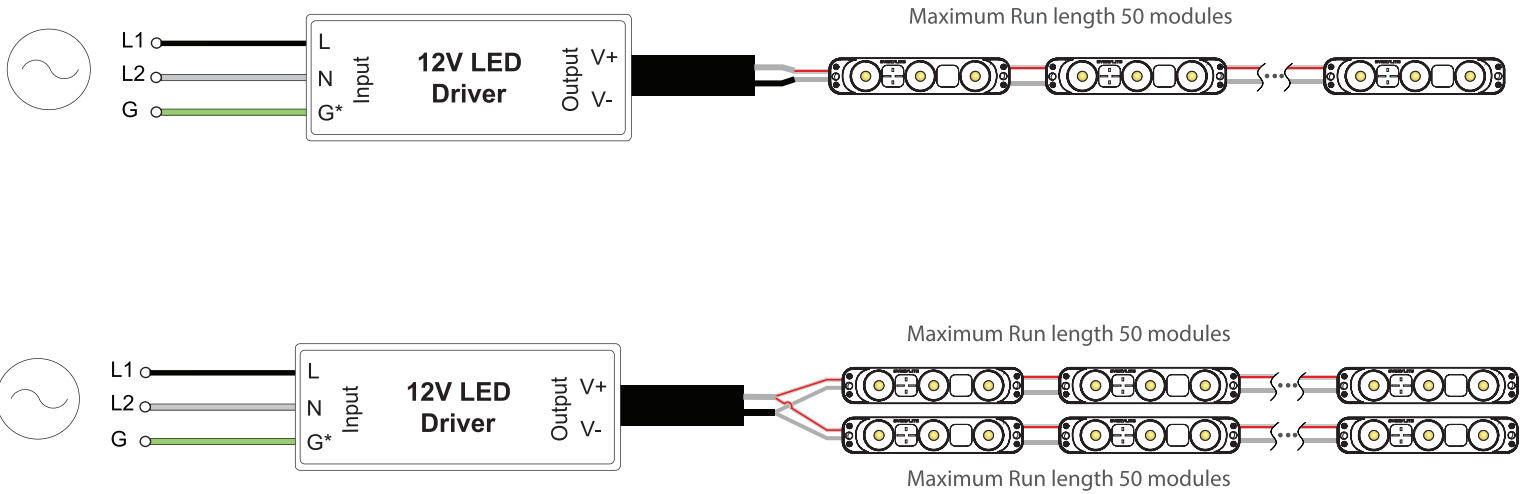
NOTE: All electrical connections should be made within the letter.

Troubleshooting

Fixture does not illuminate	See 'System Diagram'. Ensure the system is wired correctly and polarities are correct. Ensure a compatible power supply is installed.
Fixture is slowly flashing	Ensure driver is not overloaded. An overloaded driver will cause the internal auto-reset to trip repeatedly.
Some LEDs are not functional	Ensure fixture has not been bent excessively, causing components and solder to detach from circuit board.
Lights are flickering	Ensure no dimmer is installed. If lights continue to flicker, check for loose connections.
